## January

Fresh Start ~ Start the New Year the right way. Create a Planner, use our Free Downloads, Clean your Craft Room. Get in the mood for a fresh start for 2021.

Water Colour Background ~ Create any project with a Water Colour Background.

## February

Mixed Media ~ Have fun experimenting with Mixed Media products and techniques on your project.

Mood Board (Love) ~ Get ready for Valentine's Day with inspiration from our Love Mood Board. Take anything from the Mood Board and use it as inspiration for your project.

## March

Sketch ~ Use our Sketch as Inspiration to create a project.

Masculine Project ~ Create any project suitable for a Male.

## April

Easter ~ Create an Easter themed project.

Paper Collections ~ Use papers from a variety of different Paper Collections to create a project. (Not just papers from one collection.)

May

Stencil ~ Use a Stencil in your project with ink, paint, texture paste etc.

Various Card Folds ~ Choose a Fancy Card Fold and make a card. There are many different Card Folds out there....Easel Cards, Twist and Pop Cards, Waterfall Cards, Explosion Boxes etc.

June

Mood Board with Sketch ~ Take anything from the Mood Board and use it as inspiration for your project.

Patterned Background ~ Use patterned paper or create your own pattern for the background of your project.

July

Embossing ~ Use wet or dry embossing in your project.

Tic Tac Toe ~ Choose items in a line on the Tic Tac Toe Board and include them in your project. (Tic Tac Toe image to come).

August

Masculine ~ Create any Masculine Project. Get organised for Father's Day!

Use Up Scraps ~ Find things that need using in your Craft Room and incorporate them into a project.

September

Use Acetate ~ Acetate is a clear plastic. It can be used in projects in many ways. One common way is to create a shaker element. How can you use Acetate in a project?

Clean and Simple ~ Create a Clean and Simple Project...this means white space, few embellishments, clean and limited layers, careful placement of design.

October

Sketch ~ Use our Sketch to create a project.

Stamping and Colouring ~ Break out your stamps and/or your colouring textas and create a project.

November

Tear Paper ~ Use the paper tearing technique on your project.

Christmas Cards ~ Get ready for Christmas and start making cards to send to family and friends.

Christmas Project ~ Any project with a Christmas Theme
