Christmas Shaker Card

Materials Required:

UCD1801 - Circle Cover Plate Die

12x12 White Card Stock

Red and Green Sequins

Red Glitter Card Stock

Acetate

Snowflakes

Joy Chipboard Sentiment

Foam tape

Double Sided Tape

Liquid Adhesive

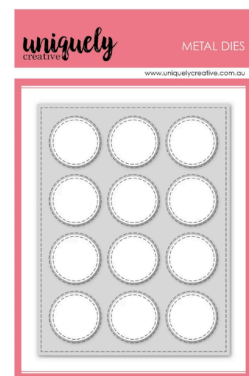
Creating the Shaker Card

Step 1 - Cut first piece of white Card Stock to 4 1/2 inches x 6 inches.

Step 2 - Cut second piece of white card stock to 6 x 9 1/2 inches.

Step 3 - Fold second piece in half. This becomes the base of the card.

Step 4 - Cut die from Red Glitter Card Stock.



Step 5 - Cut Acetate to fit the die cut.

Step 6 - Add double-sided tape to the back of the die cut.

Step 7 - Adhere Acetate to the back of the die cut.

Step 8 - Cut foam tape to fit around outside of die cut.

Step 9 - Adhere tape between each circle.

Step 10 - Sprinkle sequins into squares.

Step 11 - Remove Tape Backing.

Step 12 - Secure first piece of Cut white card stock on top of Die cut.

Step 13 - Trim edges.

Step 14 - Adhere to front of folded card stock.

Step 15 - Add a sentiment.

Step 16 - Add three snowflakes.

Step 17 - Secure with Liquid Glue.
